DIHAD College resembles a beacon of hope and inspiration in the field of education and humanitarianism.

The response was overwhelming, within just three years, the DIHAD College received over 8,125 applications from aspiring humanitarians worldwide. Ultimately, 95 students from more than 72 different nationalities around the world were selected, bringing together over 859 years of experiences and perspectives, from over 92 diverse organizations including the UN, International Organizations, NGOs, Governments, the private sector, and more. The students embodies diversity, expertise, and a shared commitment to making a difference.

The impact of the program speaks volumes. Achieving a remarkable 97% rating in program quality and excellence, the DIHAD Humanitarian College has proven to be a catalyst for positive change on a global scale.

Collaboratively, students and faculty pave the way for a brighter, more sustainable future, characterized by compassion, resilience, and equity. 


