



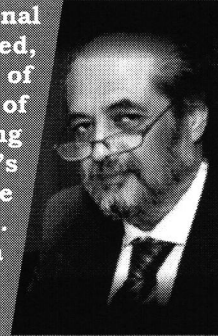

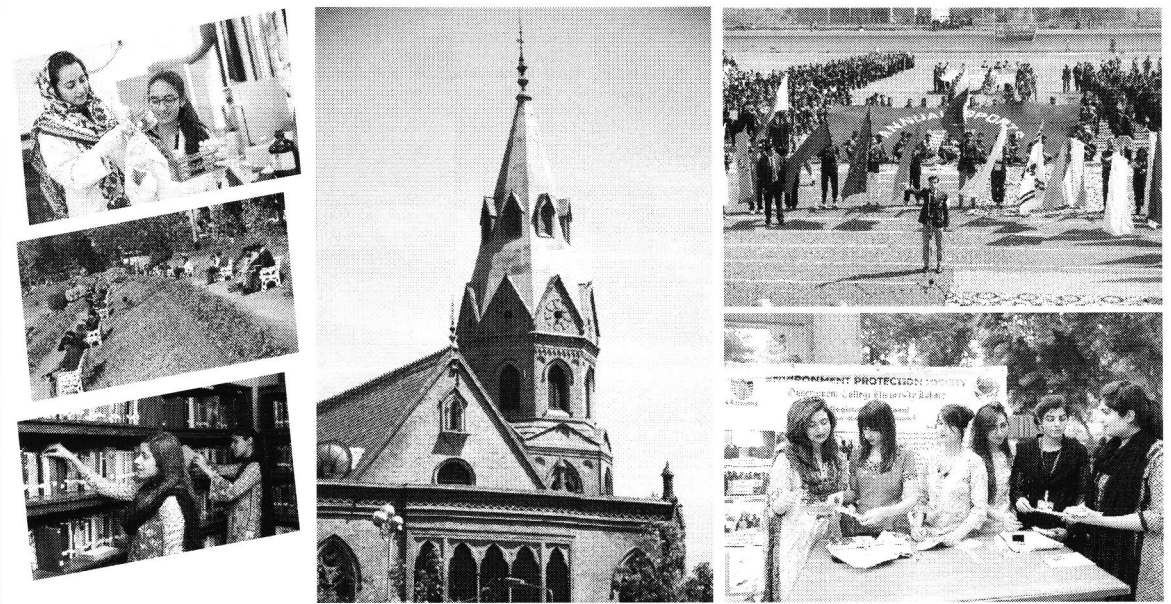

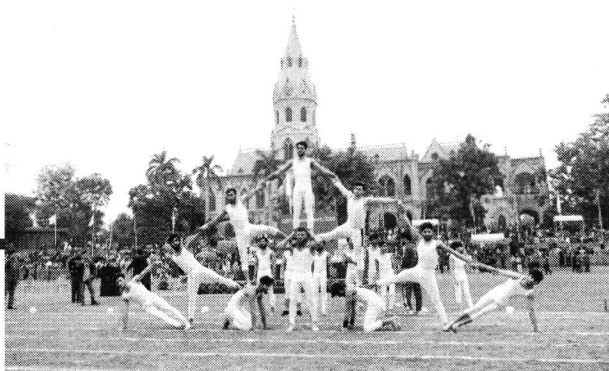
The University believes in undertaking research, consultancy and other forms of services to local and regional communities which will enrich our teaching and advance our quest for wisdom and truth.

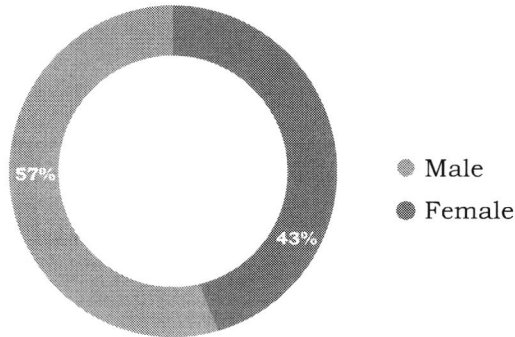

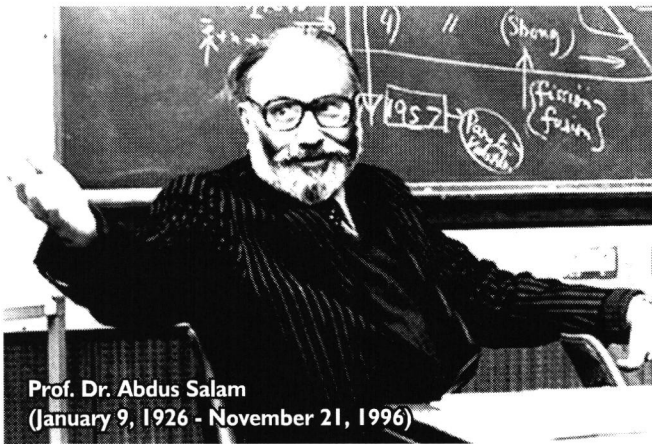
Gender Mix of Students



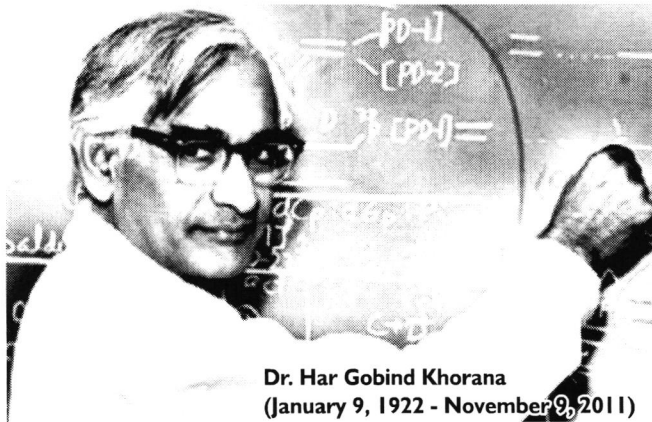

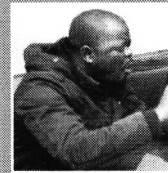

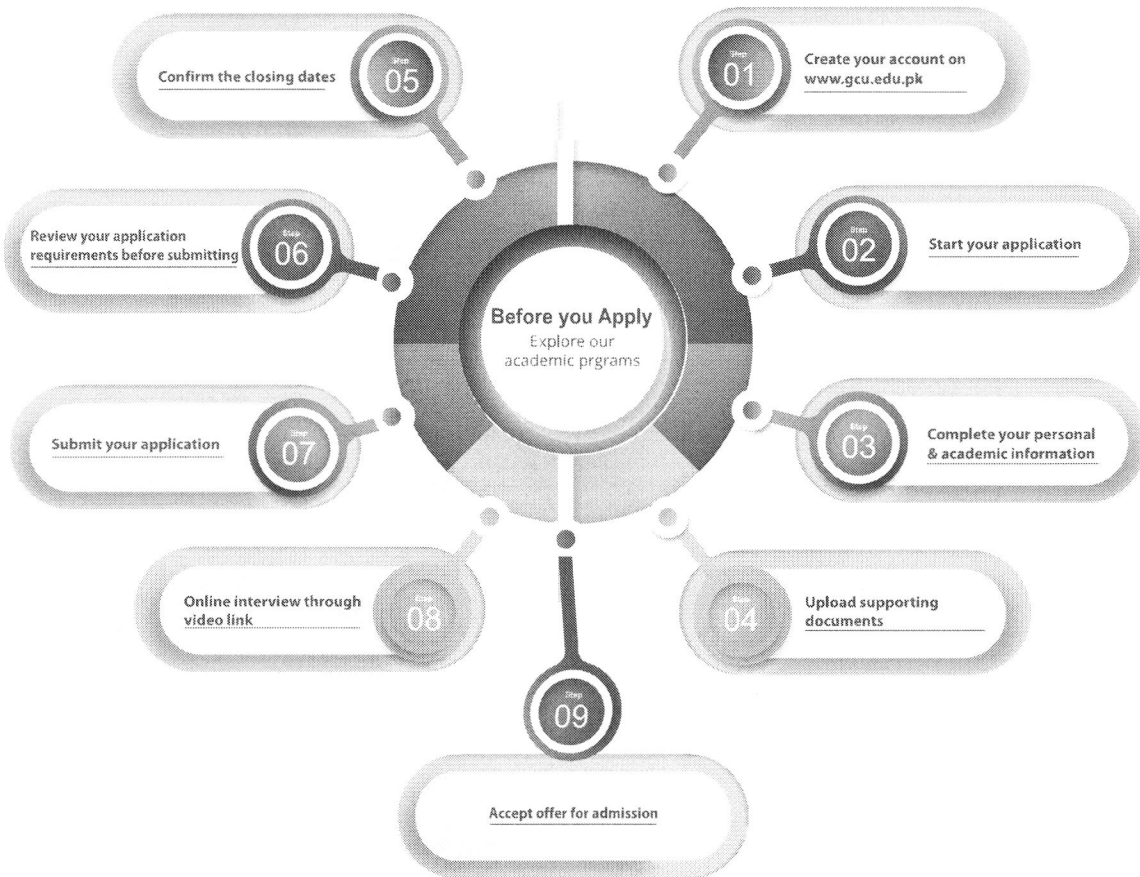
