The University of Macau (UM) is the only public comprehensive university in Macau, and has become one of the most internationalized universities in the world.

With English as the main medium of instruction, the University is committed to training and preparing our students as global citizens.







In recent years, UM has been taking initiatives for a comprehensive and structural reform and entered a new era of unprecedented growth. The University offers the research, cultural, social and recreational facilities you would expect from a top university and lots of greenery to facilitate learning, research and innovation.

Quality Education

UM offers around 130 degree programmes covering a variety of fields, and the quality education is globally recognized in various university rankings.

Teaching units at UM include Faculty of Arts and Humanities, Faculty of Business Administration, Faculty of Education, Faculty of Health Sciences, Faculty of Law, Faculty of Social Sciences, Faculty of Science and Technology, Honours College, Graduate School, and Centre for Continuing Education.

Research institutes include Institute of Chinese medical Sciences, Institute of Applied Physics and Materials Engineering, Institute of Collaborative Innovation, Institute of Microelectronics, Centre for Macau Studies, Asia-Pacific Academy of Economics and Management, and Institute of Advanced Studies in Humanities and Social Sciences.

Currently, there are more than 12,500 students at UM. For undergraduate students, the university provides a unique '4-in-1' education, which consists of discipline-specific education, general education, research and internship education, and community and peer education.





Learning Environment

The University organizes a vibrant mix of events, competitions, public lectures, seminars, visits or community services to enrich the students' life on campus. You also have opportunities to interact with our invited speakers and leading scholars. Our Library is the largest library in Macau, with an area of about 30,000 square meters and a collection of over 12 million pieces/items. The Library provides group discussion rooms as well as silent zone for individual study. There are also nearly 30 sports, cultural, and art teams, as well as about 100 student-led groups under the Students' Union and the Postgraduate Association. You can make friends with students from different cultural backgrounds.



Residential College (RC)

UM's RC system is modelled upon the house or RC system of Harvard and Yale in the US as well as the college system of Oxford and Cambridge in the UK, and has inherited the spirit of *shuyuan* (academy) during the Song and Ming dynasties in China. Adhering to the motto "Humanity, Integrity, Propriety, Wisdom, and Sincerity", the university's unique 4-in-1 education model and the RC system, which is the core of the community and peer education, aim to foster the whole-person development of the students.



UM's education mission is to cultivate responsible citizens and innovative leaders who are strong in national commitment and global competitiveness, with international outlook, meeting the needs of the advancement of Macau, their home country, and the world. The RC system thus plays a critical role in realizing the university's vision for undergraduate education.

The University has various indoor and outdoor sports facilities and you will get free entry access to most of venues by presenting your UM campus card. Our indoor sports facilities include an Olympicstandard swimming pool, a fitness room, sauna, sports pavilion, sport climbing wall, squash courts, badminton hall, table tennis room, etc.

International Student Scholarship

UM offers scholarship to International applicants of full-time Bachelor's and Master's degree programmes who meet the admission requirements of the respective degree programme. Eligible candidates will be considered automatically for the Scholarship. No separate scholarship application is required.

Scholarship Package (for Bachelor)

Waiver of:

- Tuition fee;
- Residential College fee (shared bedroom);
- Honours College certificate programme fee (if applicable); and
- Minor programme fee (if applicable).

The maximum term of the Scholarship is the normal study period of the admitted programme, which is 4 or 5 years

Scholarship Package (for Master)

Waiver of:

- Tuition fee; and
- Postgraduate House (twin room) fee

The maximum term of the Scholarship is the normal study period of the admitted programme, which is 2 or 3 years.



Experience Macau

Macau was a territory administered by Portugal and now a Special Administrative Region of China. Macau's architecture, art, religion, traditions, food and community reflect the integration of Chinese, Western and Portuguese cultures.

The Historic Centre of Macau was inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List due to its unique historical and cultural landscape. Thanks to its rich history and cultural diversity, Macau has gradually developed into a metropolitan city and currently positioning itself as the World Centre of Tourism and Leisure as it develops into a quality international tourist destination.

Climate

Macau has a humid subtropical climate and seasonal changes are heavily influenced by monsoons, the climate is warm and humid with a fairly wide variation in temperature over the year.

Spring	March – April	15 to 25°C
Summer	May – September	21 to 32°C
Autumn	October	21 to 27°C
Winter	November – February	11 to 18°C

Admission Requirement for Undergraduate Programmes

English Requirement

Students applying for a programme with English as the main teaching medium have to attend an interview to evaluate the applicant's English proficiency for admission. Applicants who have attained one of the following results may be exempted from the said interview:

1) Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL)

- Paper-based test: a minimum score of 550; or
- Internet-based test: a minimum score of 79;

2) International English Language Testing System (IELTS): Band 6.0 or above.

3) International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE): Grade C / 5 or above in English subject.

Admission Requirement for Master's Degree Programmes

An applicant of a Master's degree programme must possess a Bachelor's degree or academic background recognized as equivalent by the University of Macau. An applicant may also be required to possess other knowledge or professional experience.

Applicants currently studying in the final year of Bachelor's degree programmes may also submit applications. Successful applicants will be provisionally offered and will only be formally admitted upon successful completion of their Bachelor's degree programmes with overall result satisfying the requirements set by the respective programme.

Applicants should have achieved the equivalent* of an overall result of Grade C+ or better in the Bachelor's degree studies. (Except for the Faculty of Law). Applicants must fulfil the Language Proficiency requirement of the specific programme.

* The equivalent means 2.3 on the 4.0 GPA scale, 14 on the 20-point scale or 70 out of 100.



For 2022/2023 intake, application Period for Regular Admission for Master's Degree Programme: 15 Oct 2021 – 28 Feb 2022

English Requirement

Applicants who received their Bachelor / Master's degree from a university where the medium of instruction was not English are required to provide one of the following as proof of English proficiency:

- Obtained a Level 6 of the College English Test (CET) score of 430;
- Obtained a TOEFL[†] score of 550 (paper-based examination)/ 80 (Internet-based examination);
- An IELTS[†] overall score of 6.0 or above with no sub-score lower than 5.5;
- Passed the Level 4 or Level 8 of the Test for English Majors (TEM).

Some academic units may have different requirements for proof of English proficiency.

[†] TOEFL and IELTS scores are valid for two years from the test date.

- ✓ Via Zhuhai or nearby cities in mainland China by bus.
