



## **SLIIT Scholarships**

### **A. Introduction**

- Sri Lanka Institute of Information Technology (SLIIT), Sri Lanka recognizes students with outstanding academic performance, SLIIT offers merit based undergraduate scholarships to the students from the countries in the South Asian Region in the form of full tuition fee waivers to follow the degree programs offered at SLIIT (see appendix 1).
- SLIIT Scholarship covers the full tuition fee for the entire duration in SLIIT.
- The scholar has the option of transferring to an offshore degree program of a SLIIT foreign partner university, offered at SLIIT on completion of the SLIIT Higher National Diploma (HND) of two years duration or the first two years of the degree. In such an event the scholarship recipient will have to pay the fees that may be levied on by such University.
- Eligibility for a SLIIT Scholarship shall be determined based on,
  1. The performance at the Advanced Level Examination (London or Equivalent) namely passing three subjects in the specified stream and maintaining an average between 75%-90% (referring Appendix 3) at one and the same sitting or acquiring eligibility to gain admission to a bachelor's degree program of the nominated discipline in a university in the home country, and

**Note-** In the case of non-availability of the Advanced Level Examination Certificate, a certified letter from the Education Authority of the relevant country is requested upon the minimum qualification acquired by claiming that the student is eligible to enter a state university of that country.

**B. Terms and Conditions**

- The duration of the scholarship shall be three (03) years in case of a three-year degree program and four (04) years in the case of an Honor's degree program of SLIIT.
- The value of a 04-year SLIIT Scholarship will be in the range of USD 10,000 – USD 25,000 for Information Technology, Engineering, Business Administration, Humanities and Sciences degree programs.
- The scholar will be required to maintain good academic standing during the study program. The annual renewal or termination of the scholarship will depend on maintaining a Cumulative Grade Point (CGPA) as deemed satisfactory by SLIIT Management.

- The following documents should accompany the scholarship nominees:
  1. International student application form
  2. Copy of the Advanced Level Certificate and Transcript (London or equivalent) in proof of the successful completion of the admission requirement stipulated. [In case of a qualification equivalent to the London Advanced Level, the certificate/transcript shall be accompanied by a certification by the Examination Board of the country concerned that the holder has satisfied the admission requirements to a bachelor's degree Program in a University in the home country].
  3. Copy of the page containing the photograph and personal details in the passport.
  4. Copy of certificate of Birth
- Approximately LKR 100,000 to LKR 150,000 (USD 350 to 500) may have to be spent as living expenses in Sri Lanka monthly.
- The scholarship will not cover the cost of meals, accommodation facilities, travelling, health insurance, visa renewal (annual renewals) and other personal expenses.
- Overseas travel expenses and other related costs will have to be borne by the student.

#### **C. Selection and Visa application procedure**

- Selection of candidates from among the nominees will be based on merit.
- On being selected for the award of a scholarship the selected student will be notified about the selection by SLIIT.
- Shortlisted students will be subject to a brief online interview.
- SLIIT will assist the selected student to obtain clearance for first time arrival in Sri Lanka. On arrival in Sri Lanka, the student will have to obtain a visa valid for one year. SLIIT International Office will assist the students in this exercise. Students have the option of getting visa for full course duration by paying relevant visa fee for total years.
- Those who get the visa for one year, needs to apply for yearly visa extension, well in

advance of the visa expiration by making the applicable payment for visa extension to the Department of Immigration and Emigration in Sri Lanka.

- The application for the extension of the Visa will be subject to the following conditions.
  1. Maintenance of a satisfactory level of attendance as determined by SLIIT throughout the study program.
  2. Maintenance of satisfactory level of attainment in the examination conducted, and
  3. Display dedicated studentship.

**D. Commencement of study programmes**

The first year first semester of 2025 Academic year will be preceded with a compulsory orientation program. The Orientation commencement date and the Course Commencement date will be communicated to the selected student.

- E. The closing date for SLIIT Scholarship applicants will be 20<sup>th</sup> of August 2025 for 2025 October intake.**
