The University of Cyprus (UCY) pursues excellence in education, research and innovation through the creative and persistent efforts of highly motivated students, high-achieving young researchers and distinguished academics. Aspiring to function as a beacon of science and creativity, UCY envisions an ethical future as a leading institution in the greater Euro-Eastern Mediterranean area.

FACTS AND FIGURES

Established in 1989, and accepting its first students in 1992, UCY is the first university to be established in the island. Based in the capital of Cyprus, Nicosia, it has approximately 7.000 students, aspiring to reach a total of 10.000 students by 2020.

The University currently functions under 8 faculties, 23 departments, offering a range of 40 undergraduate programmes, and 106 postgraduate programmes (at both Master's and PhD levels). All programmes of academic study function under the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS), furthermore awarding the Diploma Supplement with DS Label.

It aspires for its campus to operate on net-zero energy in the near future.




