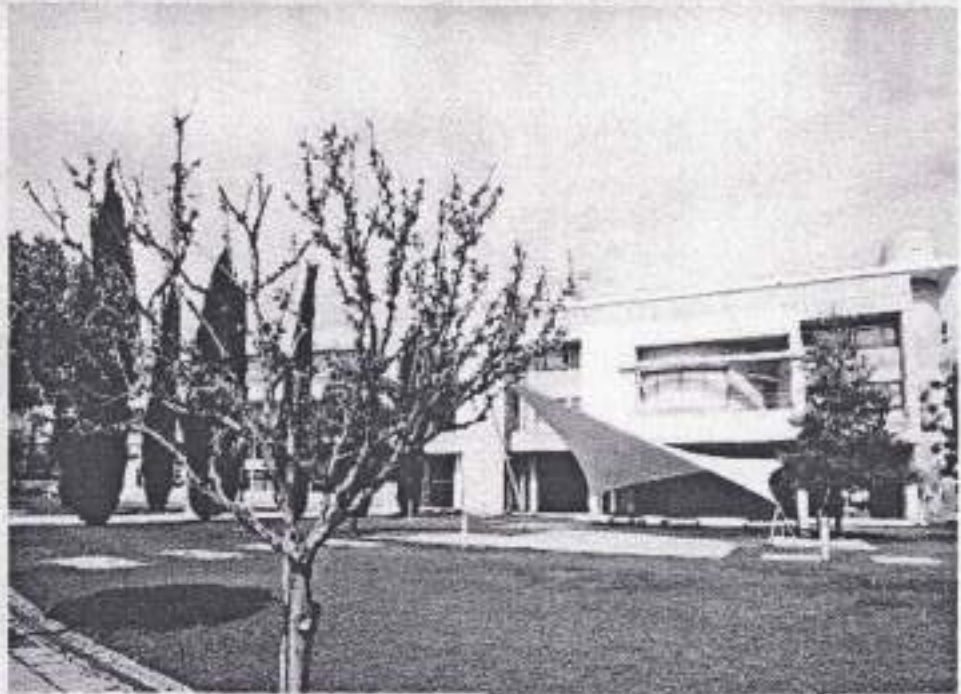

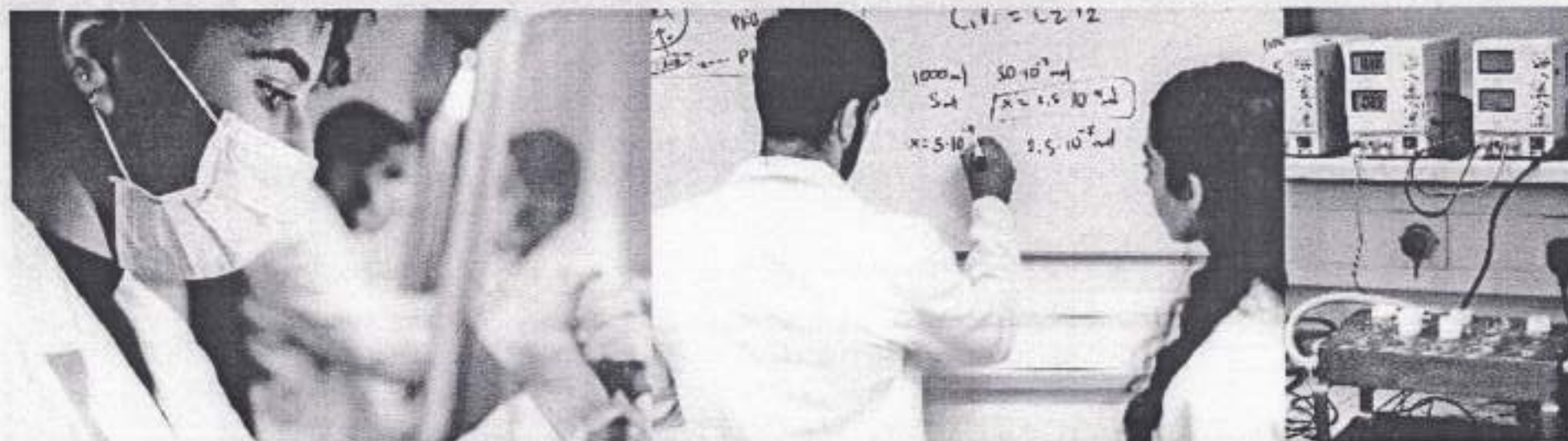
RESEARCH

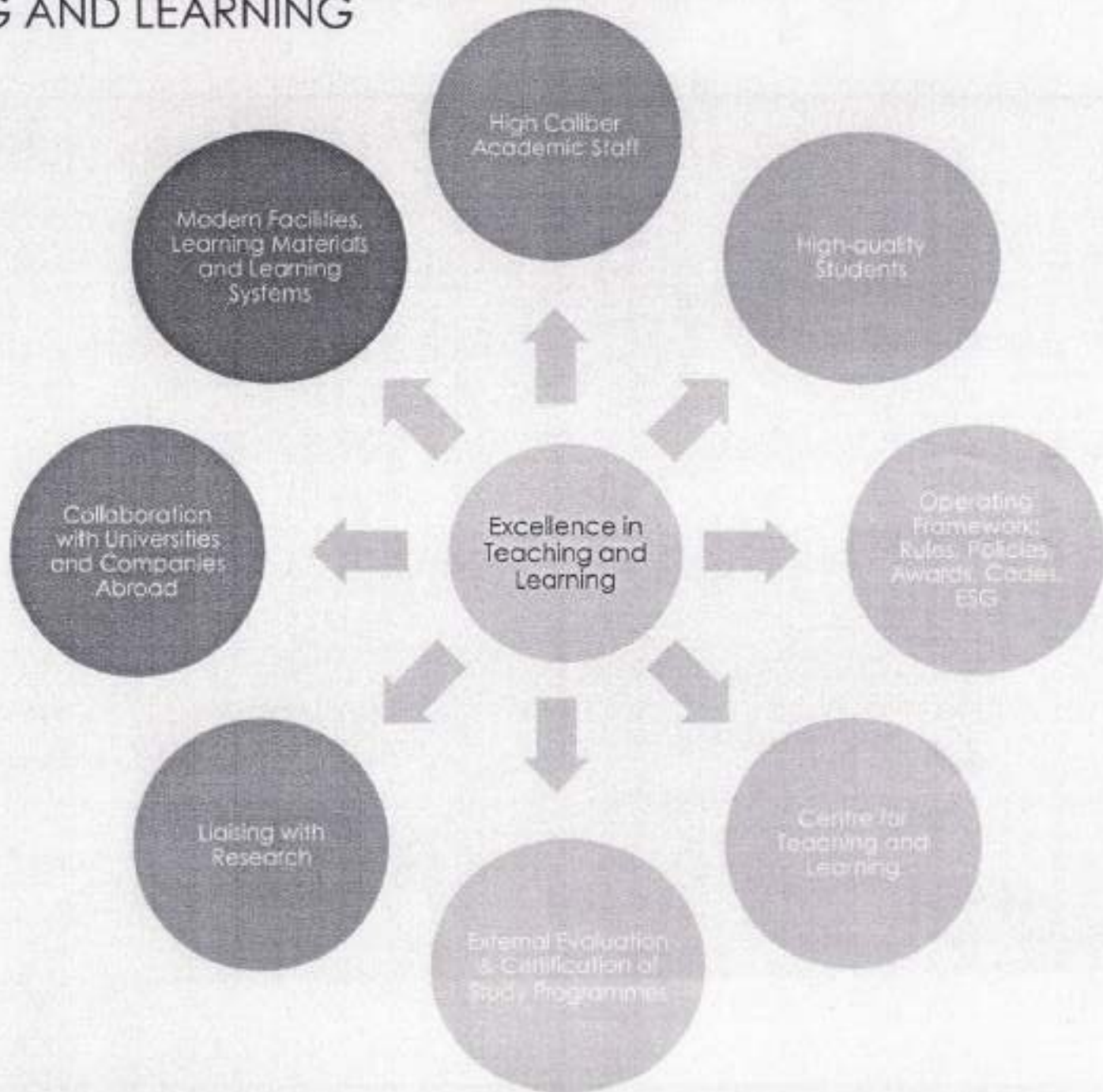

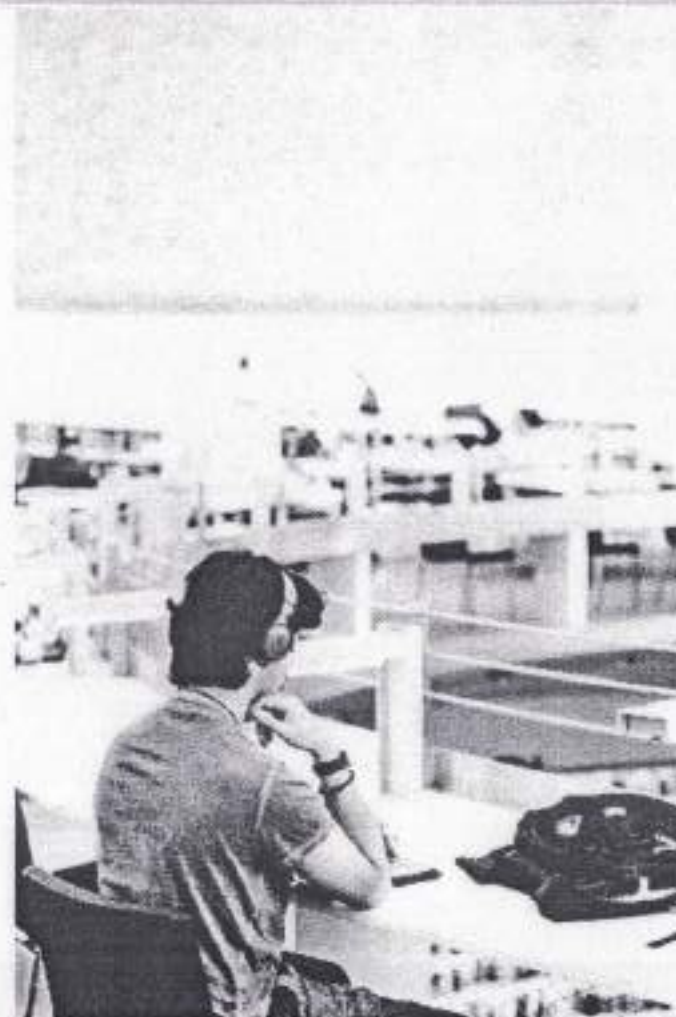

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS AND FEES - UNDERGRADUATE STUDIES

Admission based on international examinations (GCE/IGCSE/Baccalaureate) or other equivalent examinations, is offered in an additional number of places, at a rate equal to 3% of the total number of places offered through the National Entrance examinations.

The following candidates are eligible to apply:

1. Cypriots who belong to the religious groups defined by the Constitution of Cyprus (Armenians, Maronites, Latins)
2. Repatriated Cypriots
3. Cypriots who are permanent residents abroad
4. Cypriots with dual citizenship
5. Foreign nationals (from EU member states or non-EU states)
6. Greeks of the Diaspora and
7. Children of Cyprus Foreign Service Officers

Entry Requirements per Department

Tuition Fees

Cypriots and other EU Students: €3.417 per academic year, paid by the Republic of Cyprus.

Non-European Students: €6.834 per academic year.



ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS-POSTGRADUATE STUDIES

Applicants must have a University Degree awarded by an accredited institution in the country where it operates, or a Degree evaluated as equivalent to a University degree by the Cyprus Council for the Recognition of Higher Education Qualifications (KY.S.A.T.S). Individuals who will be awarded a University degree or Graduation Certificate fulfilling the necessary criteria by the end of the week that precedes registration week, are also eligible to submit an application.

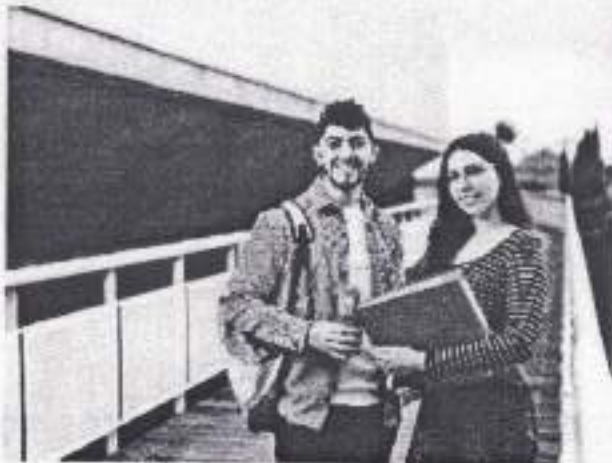
Applications for a Postgraduate Programme should include the following:

- Application through the Online Application System of the UCY.
- Copies of University Degrees or a statement of expected graduation in the month preceding enrolment in the postgraduate programme.
- University Transcripts as appropriate.
- Curriculum Vitae.
- A Short Statement (max. two pages) of the student's research goals and interests.
- Two (2) signed Letters of Recommendation.

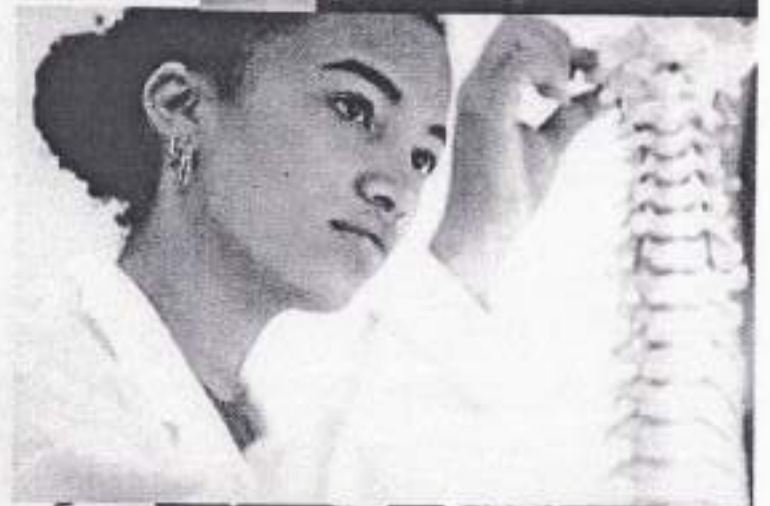
FEEES FOR POSTGRADUATE STUDIES-MASTERS

Conventional Master Programmes: €5.125

Self-funded Master Programmes:

The programme is offering a clinical practicum for which the fee is €1.000. This amount covers the expenses for clinical supervision services provided by Registered Professional Psychologists in Cyprus.





FEES FOR POSTGRADUATE STUDIES-PHD

Holders of Master degree: **€4.000.**

Non-holders of Master degree:

- Total fees **€6.500**, provided that students complete the requirements of their programme of study and obtain their PhD in six academic years (12 semesters).
- Each year of study after the 6 academic years, with a maximum length of studies being 8 academic years (16 semesters) is charged with fees at **€1.250** for each academic year (**€625** per semester). (The maximum fees charged are **€9.000**)

Doctoral Programme of Clinical Psychology

- A clinical practicum fee of **€1.000** is added for the hiring of supervision services from registered professional psychologists, to the fees of the Doctoral Programme of Clinical Psychology.





SCHOOL OF MODERN GREEK

The School of Modern Greek aims at teaching Greek to non-native speakers, nationals and foreigners, as well as to those who wish to perfect their knowledge of Greek. Greek culture courses are included in the lengthier course programmes and are offered to all students from the beginners level. They address cultural and social issues of Modern Greek society.

Full-time students that have enrolled in the UCY undergraduate and postgraduate programmes of study, as well as exchange students, have the opportunity to learn Greek at the School of Modern Greek, *free of charge*.

Moreover, non-Greek-speaking students who wish to study at the UCY programmes of study (undergraduate and postgraduate), have the opportunity to learn Greek at the School of Modern Greek, before embarking on their studies.

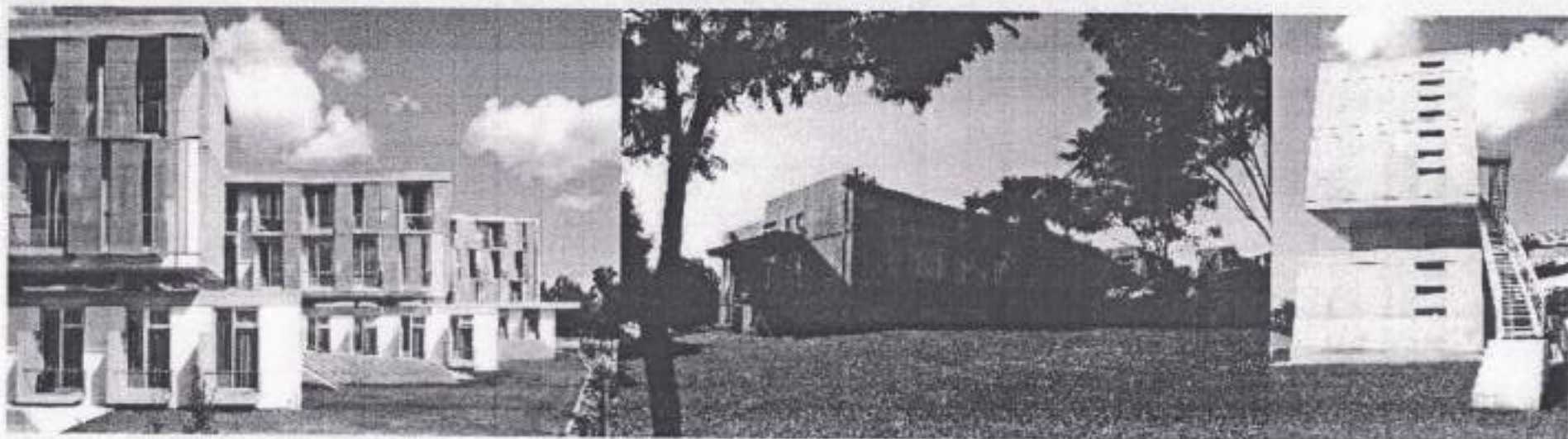

- Providing the University Community Access to its state-of-the Gym





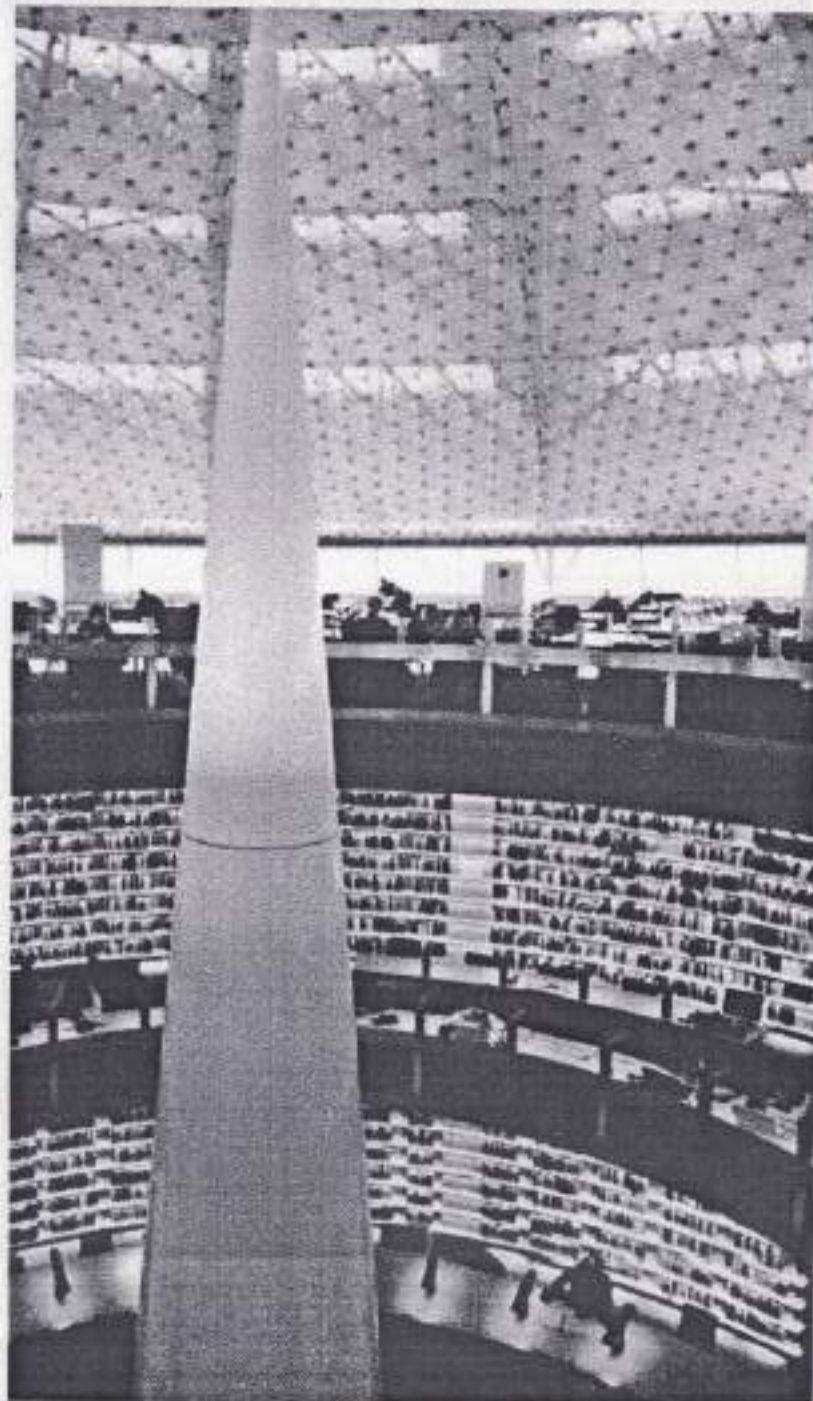
UCY LIBRARY

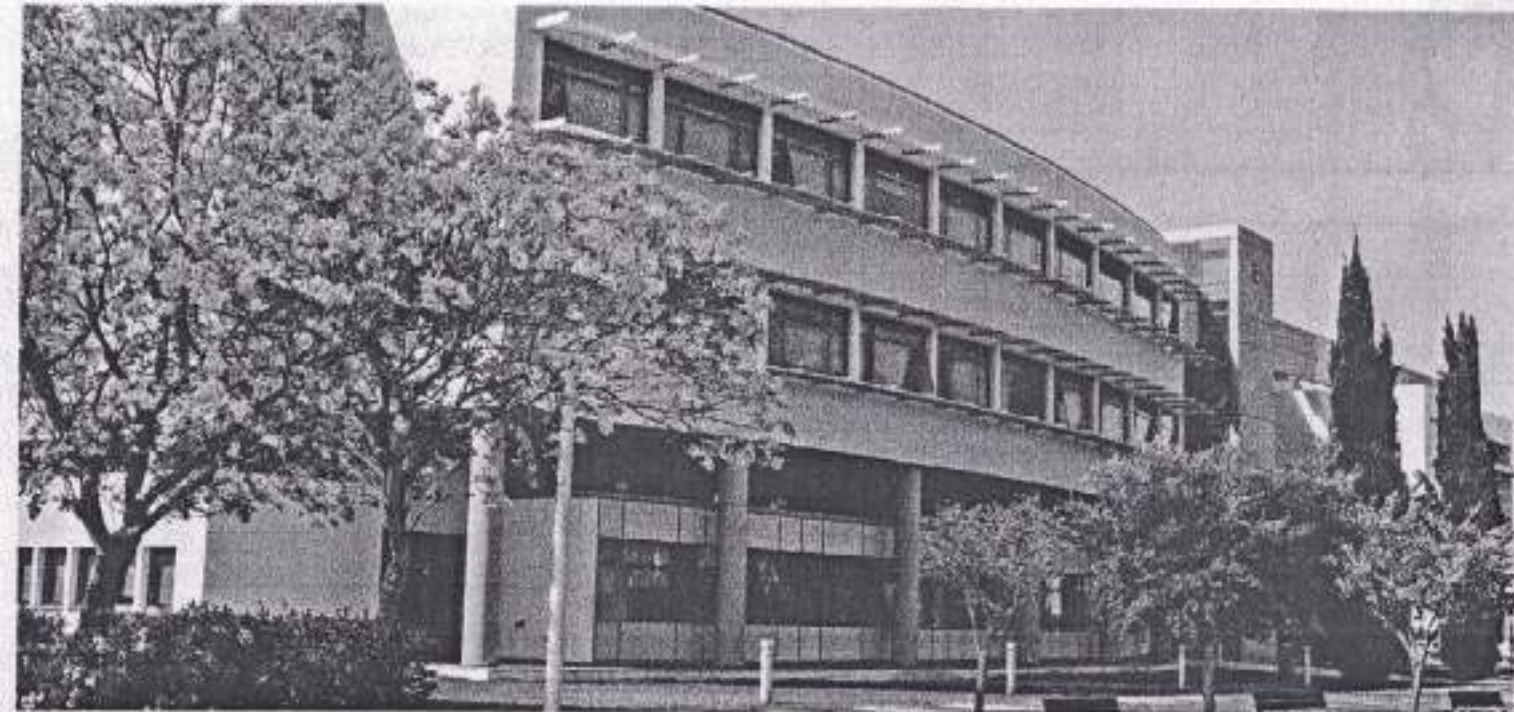

The University of Cyprus (UCY) pursues excellence in education, research and innovation through the creative and persistent efforts of highly motivated students, high-achieving young researchers and distinguished academics. Aspiring to function as a beacon of science and creativity, UCY envisions an ethical future as a leading institution in the greater Euro-Mediterranean area.

UCY was the first university to be established on the island, in 1989, accepting its first students in 1992. Based in the capital of Cyprus, Nicosia, UCY is globally networked and actively contributes to European and international scientific developments.

The University currently functions under 8 faculties and 22 departments, offering a range of 28 undergraduate programmes leading to 40 Bachelor degree titles and 104 postgraduate programmes leading to 80 Master's and 49 PhD degree titles. All programmes of academic study function under the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS), furthermore awarding the Diploma Supplement with DS Label.

RESEARCH

- 13 UCY Research Units and Centres, covering a broad spectrum within the life, social, natural and engineering sciences.
- Highest number of ERC grants in Cyprus (26 grants) since the establishment of the European Research Council in 2007: 7 Starting Grants, 8 Consolidator Grants, 2 Advanced Grants, 8 Proof of Concept Grants and 1 Synergy Grant.
- 29 Marie Skłodowska-Curie projects funded under Horizon 2020 and Horizon Europe. Apart from Postdoctoral Fellowships, UCY participates in Doctoral Networks, Staff Exchanges and in two Cofund Actions. UCY has successfully implemented 79 Marie Skłodowska-Curie projects.
- In 2022, research funding from external sources reached €30.9 million. UCY is currently participating in 370 projects. 212 are EU-funded projects under Horizon Europe, Horizon 2020, Erasmus+, Justice, Life, Cost Action and Interreg.

UCY IN HORIZON 2020

- Ranks 1st in Cyprus with 154 research projects and with a total funding of over €75,4 million.
- Ranked 137th in securing funding among 41,200 organizations participating in the Programme and 98th among all the academic institutions involved. A very honorable distinction for UCY since it surpasses, in absolute numbers, other well-known and much larger universities of Europe.
- 1st in securing funding from organisations in the 16 H2020 Widening countries which are less advanced in R&I. Under this pillar, UCY secured 23 research projects with total funding of € 28,9 million (3 Teaming Phase 2 - € 23 million, 7 Teaming Phase 1 - € 1 million, 1 Era Chair - € 2,5 million, 4 Twinning - € 1,6 million and 8 Widening Fellowships - € 1,227,529).

INNOVATION

UCY:

- Concludes around 220 Research and Innovation related contracts per year, including collaborative research contracts and other types of R&I agreements (e.g. NDAs, MTAs, copyright agreements, research subcontracting, provision of research services and technology/patent licensing agreements).
- Currently has 6 granted patents and 8 pending patent applications.
- Deals with around 90 cases of innovation and intellectual property rights management and exploitation of research results per year.
- Currently exploits IPR, through contracts, mostly for copyrighted IP (software, algorithms, tools for variety of assessments with consulting).

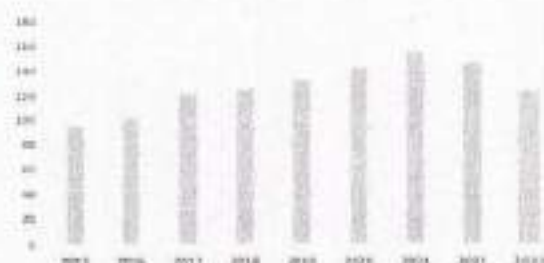
