


DISTRIBUTION OF REGIONAL CAMPUSES OFFERING HIGHER EDUCATION PROGRAMMES IN 2019










HIGHER EDUCATION ENROLLMENT IN 2019 BY GENDER




CURRENT ENROLLMENT IN HIGHER EDUCATION BY GENDER

Percentage of current enrollment in higher education by MNQF levels






GRADUATE OUTPUT IN HIGHER EDUCATION BY GENDER

Percentage of graduate output in higher education by MNQF levels






DROP-OUTS IN HIGHER EDUCATION BY GENDER
