What is the student loan scheme

The student loan scheme (June 2019-revised Usool) is opened for NEW and ONGOING students who are seeking to study/ studying ABROAD

You may apply to study ABROAD in any country. Full funding will be provided to the countries listed in the Annex 1. Partial funding will be provided to study in other countries.

Who is eligible to study under this loan scheme

Students who fulfills the minimum entry requirement of the MQA and/ the requirement from the licencing bodies are eligible to apply for this scheme

How is points and overall score calculated

Points will be given and overall score will be calculated based on the description provided in the Annex 4

What documents do I have to submit

- An assessment report classifying the level of studies has to be submitted for the programmes completed abroad which are equivalent to Olevel and Alevel
- All higher educational qualifications attained from abroad should be validated from the MQA
- If a provisional certificate is to be submitted, an assessment report from the MQA should be submitted along with the transcripts
- Copies of the certificates should be attested and both sides of the documents should be submitted (except for Olevel and Alevel certificates obtained in the Maldives)
- A document as a proof of course availability should be submitted (If applying to a license programme, the institute should be approved from the licencing body)
- Both sides of applicant's ID card copy
- Both sides of guarantor's ID card copy

What are the common mistakes in the applications

- Applied to a wrong category
- Applied to an incorrect scheme (refer to cut off date for ongoing and new students)
- No Validation/ Accreditation
- Incomplete Attestation (should be attested from a government authority or a law firm, and should include the name of the organization, name of the signatory, signature, date and logo)
- Applied to a programme not approved by the licencing bodies
- Entry requirement not met
- Repeat applications
- Incomplete applications (fill all the sections including details of the grades attained)
- Falsified information

Some Important information!

- Read the lulaan, Usool and the Annexes
- If an ongoing student, priority will be given to students with shorter duration to complete
- A student will be categorized as an ongoing student, if s/he commenced studies before 01 Jan 2019
- A student will be categorized as a new student, if s/he commences studies after 01 Jan 2019
- **All applications submitted prior to THREE days of the deadline will be checked by the MoHE. These applicants will be informed via portal to complete their applications before the deadline**
