7. **HOSTEL MESS**
- 7.1 Each resident student of the hostel will automatically be considered as a member of the hostel mess unless his membership is suspended by the Resident Warden. No member of the mess is allowed to close his mess account for a period of less than three days. In such case the student will inform the office assistant one day before doing so.
- 7.2 The hostel mess will be monitored by a Food Committee comprising of Resident students of the hostel which are appointed by the Resident Warden with the approval of the Provost. The continuation of the members of the Food Committee will be decided upon their progress. The Food Committee shall prepare a menu on weekly/monthly basis with the approval of the Resident Warden.
- 7.3 The Resident Warden shall supervise and check the mess daily or on alternate day. The Assistant Provost or Provost may make surprise visits to the Hostel Mess.
- 7.4 The Resident Students must pay their mess dues before the 15th of each month. A fine amounting to 10% of the total dues (rounded to the closest multiple of 10) shall be charged for late payment of dues after the due date. The Resident Warden reserves the right to change the amount of fine to be imposed on the resident students in case of late payment.
- 7.5 The Hostel Mess shall remain open during the time prescribed for each meal. Residents shall not be allowed to demand food after the prescribed time limit.
- 7.6 All the members of the mess shall take their meals in the Dining Hall of the hostel. No meals shall be served in their rooms by the hostel bearers.
- 7.7 Smoking is strictly prohibited in the hostel mess and its premises. Moreover resident students must not create any sort of disturbance or discomfort to their fellow students in the hostel mess.
- 7.8 Residents shall not use hostel lawns, common room and other places for lunch, dinner, breakfast or tea.
- 7.9 Residents of the hostel are not allowed to bring food from outside the hostel into the hostel mess.
- 7.10 In case of closing mess permanently, student should provide proper medical certificate.
8. **HOSTEL GATES TIMINGS**

- 8.2 A Boarder card will be issued by the provost office to the residents. All the students are subject to keep the Boarder card with them in the hostel and university premises. This card will serve as a proof of student's identity as a Boarder. No student will be allowed entry into the hostel without his Boarder Card.
9. **NOTICES & WALL CHALKING**
No resident will be allowed to paste or exhibit any notice printed/hand written or other material, in writing anywhere in the hostel except those duly signed by the hostel warden. No resident student is allowed to engage in wall chalking inside the hostel premises. Any violation of this rule is subject to strict disciplinary action.
10. **COMPLAINTS**
All complaints about matters relating to the hostels shall be reported to the warden of the hostels. Students must never take any matter into their own hands, otherwise they'll be held liable for strict disciplinary action.
11. **UTENSILS, FURNITURE & ELECTRIC INSTALLATIONS**
- 11.1 Residents are not allowed to take utensils from the dining hall/hostel mess and furniture from common room to their rooms or other hostels. Residents are not allowed to move any hostel furniture or other items from their designated places. In case of any violation stern disciplinary action will be taken against him/her.
- 11.2 Every Resident of the hostel will be provided with a bed, a table and a chair. He/she will be responsible for any loss or breakage thereof. Residents who will destroy or damage any hostel property shall pay for damages and will be heavily fined.
- 11.3 All rooms of hostels have necessary electric fittings. Student/s residing in these rooms shall be responsible for the proper use and safety of these fittings.

International Students are admitted against reserved seats if their names are recommended by the Higher Education Commission of Pakistan (HEC) OR Economic Affairs Division (Ministry of Education, Government of Pakistan) (EAD)

Eligibility Criteria:

a. Pre-requisite Qualification

Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) Pre-Engineering (Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics)
OR

Equivalent qualification with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics. NED University does not accept any qualification without subjects Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics, equivalent to Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) Pre-Engineering. Candidates must also have passed Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) Pre-Engineering Examination with at least 60% aggregate marks.

b. Pre-Admission Entry Test

For admission in the NED University candidate has to qualify Pre-Admission Entry Test of the University based on the Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) OR equivalent level subjects of English, Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics. OR

Foreigners and Overseas Pakistani candidates may take SAT examination in lieu of Pre-Admission Entry Test – he/she must score at least 800 and 1500 respectively in SAT I and SAT II in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics.

c. English Language Skill

English Language Skill is being tested through Pre-Admission Entry Test.

8.6 OTHER EXPENSES

The student may find it convenient to own some books of fundamental nature which help him not only in the First Year but throughout his/her stay at the University and even beyond. Judicious purchase of such books with the guidance of his/her teachers is recommended. An outlay of about Rs. 10,000/- in the first instance for books and stationery should generally be adequate. In addition, he is expected to own drawing instruments, scientific calculator and sets of tools which may require additional Rs.6,000/-.

- ✓ 5. Foreign students/ Children of Pakistani ex-patriots (Overseas students) in addition to the usual prescribed fees of the University and the Department concerned, shall pay US dollar 1,000/- once at the time of admission in the particular bank accounts of the University.
6. The Students who cannot appear in examination because of genuine excuse/ reason shall be allowed to appear in re-sit examination within one week after the examination subject to the payment of special examination fee of Rs.5,000/- for one course. If the number of courses is more than one then a lump sum of Rs. 10,000/- shall be paid as special examination fee to the department.
7. The departmental dues will be utilized for department's development, examination expenses (including thesis evaluation, viva voce etc.) ID Cards, Computer Labs, Lab. Maintenance / Chemicals, Equipment, Departmental Society fee, etc. Proper account of departmental dues will be maintained by the departments and all the expenditure shall be incurred after pre-audit.
8. All departments/ Institutes/ Colleges/Centers will deposit all the fees except departmental dues in respective University's main income account.
9. University Regular Teachers/ Employees (including retired), their spouses, children and relatives studying in any of University Department/Centre/Institute/Constituent College under regular classes will be granted concession from payment of fees as under:
 - a) i. 100% concession in tuition fee, Medical Fee, Mosque Fund, PUSTC/ PUWSTC Fee for university teachers / employees, their spouses and children
 - ii. 100% concession in tuition fee to brother, sister, nephew/ niece or orphan dependent on university teacher or employee
 - b) Self-Supporting /Replica classes:
 - i. 50% concession in tuition fee along with total Medical Fee, Mosque Fund, PUSTC/ PUWSTC for university teachers / employees, their spouses and children.
 - ii. 50% concession in tuition fee to brother, sister, nephew/ niece or orphan dependent on university teacher or employee.
 - iii. 100% concession in Departmental dues (for regular & self-supporting classes)
