

Eligibility criteria for the above-mentioned courses are as under:

(A) MBBS/BDS :

- (1) A candidate must have secured a minimum of 50% aggregate marks with at least 50% in Physics, Chemistry and Biology (Botany & Zoology) separately and 50% in English in the qualifying examination (equivalent to IO+2 standard at CBSE in India - equivalent certificate from AIU, New Delhi is required to be enclosed).
- (2) NEET – A candidate required to obtain minimum of marks at 50th percentile in National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET) conducted by NTA.
- (3) Candidates applying for MBBS seat at AIIMS, New Delhi should check the fee details at AIIMS website.

(B) B.E./B.Tech:

Candidate must have secured a minimum of 60% aggregate marks with at least 60% in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics separately and 50% in English in the qualifying examination (equivalent to IO+2 standard of CBSE in India - equivalence certificate from AIU, New Delhi).

(C) B.Pharmacy :

Candidate must have secured a minimum of 60% aggregate marks with at least 60% in Physics, Chemistry, Biology (Botany & Zoology) separately and 50% in English in the qualifying examination (equivalent to IO+2 standard of CBSE in India - equivalence certificate from AIU, New Delhi).
